There will be no entry fees for the show this year.

Each member can enter up to three (3) pieces of art. They can be new or old and may have been entered before.

The show will not be judged this year.

There will be no prizes this year, except for the "People's Choice Award", which will be a cash award. There will be no ribbons awarded for the show this year.

Spanish Village has said there will be no reception for this show.

There will be no raffle this year. 2019 ribbon winner's donations will roll over to the 2021 show.

<u>Categories</u>: The categories include ALL techniques regardless of the category you are in. They are only to provide information to the public:

Vessels: Art glass created to act as a container or vessel, i.e. bowls, plates and vases

<u>Sculpture:</u> 3 Dimensional object or assemblage designed to be viewed from all sides, usually non-functional <u>Wall Art:</u> Construction, wall mounted or framed glass art meant to be displayed on a wall, or hung in a window

Wearable Art: Art glass that can be worn as jewelry or Art-to-Wear

Novice: Artist must have less than 2 years exhibition experience in any type of glass

<u>Mixed Media</u>: Work that features glass as a key element to the design, or as a focal aspect to the piece in combination with other mediums.

A WORD ABOUT THIS SHOW:

Membership is required for application to the show. To apply go to www.agasc.org where you may pay with PayPal. All members are encouraged to participate. We emphasize educating the public about art glass, and welcome all levels.

ONE MORE THING:

Your work does not have to be complete to send in this application. We do need the title of the piece, dimensions, category, and the price. You must deliver the work on the afternoon of August 25th

APPLICATION PROCESS: All entry forms must be received by **midnight Sunday, August 16th.** Email completed forms to; <u>sdjon369@gmail.com</u> Or snail mail completed forms to: Jon Simpson, 4483 33rd Place, San Diego, CA 92116

The AGASC Board requires everyone who enters the show to volunteer for one spot and sit one day of the show gallery exhibit.

ART DROP OFF: Tuesday, August 25th, 4:00 to 7:00 PM. Bring your art to Gallery 21 in Spanish Village between 4pm-7pm. **You may drive on the patio AFTER 4:30pm.** Work must be display ready and include special stands or hangers required to display the piece. (Mark displays NFS if not to be sold with piece.) Hanging pieces MUST already have hanging wire or loops that will be compatible with the existing hanging system. Items that are incomplete, damaged or will not hang using the Gallery 21 hanging system will not be accepted.

ART PICK UP: Monday, September 7th from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm. (We MUST be out of Gallery 21 by 5:00pm) You may **NOT** drive on the patio. If someone other than yourself is picking up your art, you must call ahead to verify. Please call the Art Glass Guild 619-702-8006 between 11am-4pm any day to verify who will be picking up your artwork. Any artwork not picked up by 5pm on September 7th becomes the property of the AGASC.

THE "NOT SO FINE PRINT"

1. All Artists must be current members of the Art Glass Assoc. of Southern California (AGASC).

2. All glass pieces must be designed and fabricated by the applicant. No assists or group projects unless acknowledged upon application.

3. All entries must be for sale.

4. AGASC has the right to refuse any entry.

5. All art must be ready to hang and/or stands to be supplied by the artist. Mark displays NFS (Not for Sale) if not to be sold with piece. Wall Art must hang using the Gallery 21 hanging system – no sawtooth hangers. Hanging pieces MUST already have hanging wire or loops that will be compatible with the existing hanging system. No nails or screws allowed in ANY walls.

6. Pieces must be at least 51% handmade glass (excluding Mixed Media category) and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Pedestal pieces cannot extend beyond 30" x 30".

7. Items that are sold as cash and carry may be replaced by the artist with a like for like item. Dimensions of item must be within 2 inches of the sold piece. The artist will be contacted and given this option should a piece be sold and taken during the show. The delivery of purchases of items sold with shipping will be the responsibility of the artist. 30% of the sales price will be added as the charge for shipping, unless you say otherwise.

8. All artwork will remain in the show through September 6th, except those that sold. The artist must pick up remaining artwork or a designated person pre-arranged with the AGASC at pick up time. Art not picked up on Monday, September 7th will become the property of the AGASC.

9. No interactive art allowed.

10. Photographs are the property of the AGASC and may be used for publicity, on our website and in the newsletter.

11. All participants must man the show for 5 hours and volunteer to participate in organizing the show.

12. 20% of all sales will go to Gallery 21 and 10% will go to the AGASC.

13. The AGASC and its agents are in no way responsible for loss, theft, damage, or breakage of items. Every effort will be made to protect your work.

14. You must wear a mask at all times when in the gallery and may have your temperature taken before entering the gallery.
